\$3000 prize purse given out – largest in state of KY

Report issued to ETCB thanking them – Mike & Brandon

Event proceeds of \$1,990.32 not agreeing with Treasurer number of \$924.10 – must look into

Discussed how to grow this event more next year

Money not the only answer – Swope interested in supporting next year

Time of year discussed - do later when weather is better

Schedule better around other competing events

Maybe get national sanctioning – Investigate what and how?
Discussed split between race team and club for MTB Race proceeds
Suggested split of 60% Race Team, 40% Club
