Ride is scheduled for August 18<sup>th</sup>. Flyer is ready and 3 routes are planned (23, 62, and 100 miles). Brian Smith and Scott to make copies for distribution. Flyers to be dropped off at local bike shops, fitness centers, etc., along with copies sent to other bicycle clubs, past tour and MTB Race participants and more distant bike shops. Randy is working on mapping the routes. This will be advertised as a ride along central Kentucky historical sites like the Monastery, Railroad Museum and Lincoln Historical sites. Official name is Central Kentucky Heritage Bicycle Tour. Start/Finish to be from the Grace Heartland Church on Pear Orchard Road in Elizabethtown. T-shirt design is finished. Get free T-shirt for early registration. Others can buy for \$10/each. Registration fee to be \$25/participant. Need to solidify location for all needed SAG stops. We do have the park in Glendale. Also discussed having at the Railroad Museum location.
