Crashes and Dogs

Jason Propes reported on crashes, the law and liability. There is an article in Bicycling July 09. Accident with car is treated same as vehicular, requires police report if there is damage. If damage, state law requires a police report if over \$500 or if insurance report has to be filed.

Remain calm, get out of the road if possible and access damage. Get name, address and phone number. Call ambulance if necessary. If they do not have insurance, the courts may suggest they pay for damage instead of jail time. Your home owners insurance could cover damage, contact your insurance company and check this out. Civilian collision report KSP 232 available at www.kentuckystatepolice.org. Fill it out yourself and send to Frankfort and keep one copy for yourself. Copies will be available at Bullmoose Bros. also.

If a dog is involved try to find owner. Their homeowners insurance could pay damage. You could also try your homeowners insurance. Call police if necessary, they will be a neutral party. Carmen distributed KRS 258.235 copies on dog laws to members.
