R-Cubed quoted us \$0.08/copy for 2,000 tri-fold brochure copies which would be \$160 black/white folded copies. An additional discount can be had with vendor advertising. Color copies would run \$450. General club brochures will be done after the race has been completed. They will be placed at bike shops and used for general distribution where we see a need.
